Students will be considered for parking tags according to the following priorities:

1. Successful enrollment in internship classes and/or zero hour (before school) music classes
2. At least a 3.0 GPA on the 4.67 scale (seniors); at least a 3.0 GPA on the 4.67 scale (juniors); at least 2.67 GPA on the 4.0 scale (sophomores). Note: Sophomores are eligible for parking after senior and junior applications have been processed and spots are still available.
3. Involvement in school or community volunteer activities that begin prior to 4 p.m. and meet on a regular basis.
4. Employment after school is NOT considered as a criterion.

Please list the Winter/Spring Nicolet extracurricular activities and/or community service activities in which you will be involved.

Do not include payment with this application. Students who have been approved for a parking tag, your name will be posted on the High School Office Window starting the week of January 23rd, 2012. If approved for a parking tag, please submit payment (in the form of **CASH** or a **CHECK** only, made out to Nicolet High School) to the High School Office by January 30th, 2012. You will receive your parking tag at this time. You **MUST** have your tag visible in your car in order to park in the high school lot. Student Parking and Driving Regulations

1. The parking fee is **\$200** per semester. I understand that if I lose my spot for any reason, the fee is not refundable. Permits are for one semester only. Students MUST reapply at the beginning of each semester.
2. Copies of the vehicle registrations for all of the vehicles (maximum two) and a copy of your driver's license must be attached to this form. If the information changes, inform Mr. Kestner. If a student drives a different vehicle from the one attached to the parking tag, inform Mr. Kestner. Failure to do so may result in a ticket.
3. **TAGS MUST BE VISIBLY DISPLAYED ON THE REAR VIEW MIRROR OR FRONT WINDSHIELD. THE VEHICLE WILL BE TICKETED IF THE TAG IS NOT DISPLAYED PROPERLY.** Any vehicle receiving a third municipal ticket for illegal parking will be towed at the owner's expense. Whenever possible, the student will be notified each time they receive a ticket and will acknowledge, in writing, that they have been notified that their vehicle will be towed upon receiving the third ticket. This will be strictly enforced.
4. Completed applications must be turned in by the deadline January 20th, NOON in order to be considered for a parking permit. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS.** Business internship students must also adhere to this deadline. Once initial applications have been processed, applications received after the January 20th, 2012 deadline will be considered if additional parking spots are still available.
5. Students who fail to comply with stated parking regulations will forfeit their privileges. Causes for suspension or permanent loss of parking permits may include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. Allowing someone else to use your parking tag.
 - b. Failure to comply with safe driving rules and regulations on campus and on adjacent streets.
 - c. Parking illegally, in the horseshoe, or No Parking Zones on Nicolet property.
 - d. Parking in Nicolet High School Faculty/Staff Lots.
 - e. Disciplinary action /Suspension(s) from school.
 - f. Tardies (unexcused):
 - 1) 1st offense – 5 or more tardies to 1st hour – loss of parking privileges for two weeks
 - 2) 2nd offense – 3 or more tardies to 1st hour – loss of parking privileges for one month
 - 3) 3rd offense – 1 or more tardies to 1st hour – loss of parking privileges for remainder of semester
 - g. Truancies:
 - 1) 1st offense – 5 or more truancies, all or part of day – loss of parking privileges for two weeks
 - 2) 2nd offense – 3 or more truancies, all or part of day – loss of parking privileges for one month
 - 3) 3rd offense – 1 or more truancies, all or part of day – loss of parking privileges for semester
6. If students are parked illegally, a municipal ticket will be issued for the first two offenses. For three offenses and beyond, the vehicle will be ticketed and towed at owner's expense. No further notification will be given.
7. School officials, including police liaison officers, may search any vehicle owned or operated by a student on school grounds at any time without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant if they have reasonable suspicion that there is evidence of a crime or infraction of a school rule or contraband in the vehicle.
8. There are no parking permits for 9th graders.
9. You do not need a parking permit to park at Nicolet during final exam week. Having a parking spot during the semester does not guarantee you a spot during final exam week.

Keep in mind that parking on campus is a privilege, not a right.
